Show an observant, measured approach through a single detail.

Before walking through the front door, pause at the corner of the house. This fictional example shows a downspout outlet ending beside the foundation, with exposed soil nearby.

That view alone does not establish a basement leak. It leaves useful questions: where does water travel during rain, and how does the surrounding ground drain?

A helpful explanation separates what is visible from what still needs checking.

Save this as a question for your next walk around a home. General drainage reference: PNNL / DOE, Gutters and Downspouts.

An inspector should check the wording to avoid implying a leak diagnosis.

One field story, one educational post and one process story. If there is no new field material, choose verified educational content instead of inventing a visit.

"Your three posts for the week are ready. Please review the text and dates. Have a new photo or update? Add a short note. Field stories stay on hold until you confirm them."
An operating-script example. SMS and KakaoTalk delivery are not connected.

4. Review and plan a date.

1. Does the caption match the image? Remove unsupported causes, readings and tests.
2. May the material be public? Check permission and remove identifying details.
3. Are there unsupported promises about service inclusion, price, credentials or safety?
4. Has the inspector read it? Silence does not approve a field story.
5. Are the language, channel and date right? Korean and English are alternatives for the same post.

Available: real sign-in and storage, source intake, basic drafts, editing, review and planned dates. Not connected: live generative AI, social publishing, SMS/KakaoTalk and general signup email. Planning a post does not publish it.

Four short lines from the field.

Site code / where and what you observed / what remains unknown / photo permission. Leave unknown information as unknown.

Review three posts once a week. Without new material, use verified educational content or fewer posts rather than inventing a visit.
